III. Discussion Topics:

1. Adding verbiage to the curriculum documents - do we need to add a signature line for Director/Faculty, as appropriate (i.e. when adding/removing an English or math prerequisite)?

The committee was not opposed to adding additional signature lines, however, this process should already be taking place. It was suggested that instead information be added to the Curriculum Manual regarding the responsibility of Division Director/Faculty to speak with affected divisions for feedback before submitting documentation. Additionally, it was suggested that a statement be added to the Division Director signature line (since Division Directors can sign submit and sign paperwork without faculty approval) stating 'By signing below you are attesting that all affected divisions and teaching faculty have been made aware of the proposed changes'. D. Schoenenberger agreed that adding a statement on the Division Director signature lines is the best course of action.

2. Limit on items discussed within one meeting

The committee suggested instead of putting a limit on the number of items accepted for an upcoming months meetings, meetings can simply be split to meet twice a month instead of one very long meeting if there are more than 35 items and items cannot be grouped for approval. Additionally, if the conversation extends past our meeting timeframe the remainder of the discussion can be held the following day if needed: Information on this should be added to the upcoming revised Curriculum Manual.

3. Meeting months and last meeting for programmatic changes

It was asked what the committee thought if curriculum meetings were back up to February as the last meeting for programmatic changes and March as the last meeting for all non-programmatic changes so that programmatic changes have time to be entered before veteran registration for Fall. Instead of pushing the curriculum meetings back to March as being the last cycle meeting, advising suggested pushing the veteran/all-student registration dates out for Fall 2025 (for FY26) as it would resolve issues in their area as well.

4. Expectations of Curriculum Committee Members

Faculty/Division Directors should ensure curriculum is relevant and meets the needs of the occupation, continuing education, workforce training, accreditation, and transfer institutions. As mentioned above, before submission of forms divisions should ensure affected divisions have been notified of the changes. Forms are to be submitted to the Coordinator of Curriculum and Academic Systems (CCAS) by the document due date. The CCAS reviews the documents and distributes the preliminary agenda to division directors and committee members one week prior to the division meeting. Divisions are to review all documents at their division meeting and bring any concerns to the official curriculum meeting. A representative of the division (Division Director or curriculum member) must be present at the official curriculum meeting to discuss their divisions proposed change and official members will take a vote.

5. Recommended vs. Preferred

D. Poole suggested changing areas in the catalog suggesting a course (ex: *ENG-112 is recommended) from *recommended* to *preferred*. D. Schoenenberger agreed with the change but stated that our free elective areas should remain with the wording *recommended*.
