  - a. Kendra Perry reviewed the different aspects of each LibGuide.
  - b. Main takeaways
    - i. We need an updated syllabus statement that addresses plagiarism with AI tools.
    - ii. Expectations do not need to be the same across all divisions, so faculty need a choice of templates that can be adapted for different disciplines.
    - iii. A codified system was suggested from an earlier meeting with the English & Humanities faculty and other campus stakeholders:
      - 1. Red No Al usage
      - 2. Orange Partial AI usage
      - 3. Green Full permitted AI usage
- 3. Consensus and suggestions for next steps:
  - a. Create an ad-hoc committee to address the ongoing issue
  - b. Ensure the focus of the discussion will be on generative AI tools
  - c. Proceed with sharing the syllabus statement draft for feedback across campus
