III. Discussion Topics:

1. Piloting Watermark Curriculum Management

We plan to pilot the new Watermark Curriculum Management software in February with the Business & Technology and Mathematics & Science divisions for the remainder of this FY26 curriculum cycle. The software will be used by all seven divisions starting the FY27 curriculum cycle.

2. New and Inactive Program Notification

D. Schoenenberger announced that new programs and inactive programs will be brought to curriculum as 'notifications' not 'proposals'. She states that the president and BoT ultimately approve the closing and creation of programs so there will be nothing to approve by the committee for new or inactive programs. D. Schoenenberger notified the committee that the following programs will be inactive for FY27: Dance Concentration, Arts and Sciences, A.A., Interactive Design and Game Development Concentration, Information Systems Technology, A.A.S., and Web and Multimedia Technology, A.A.S.

Submitters of proposals should be doing their due diligence and reaching out to affected divisions prior to submitting a change for feedback/notification.
