Getting Started at HCC

Military Personnel/Veterans

1. **Apply for Admission** – Apply online at www.hagerstowncc.edu/admissions.
2. **Submit Official Transcripts** – Credit may be granted for a variety of formal military, technical, and educational programs based on the student's program at HCC. <https://www.hagerstowncc.edu/admissions/application-process>.
3. **Complete the Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** – Students using VA benefits may also be eligible for Federal Financial Aid. For more information, go to <https://www.hagerstowncc.edu/financial-aid> or call 240- 500-2473.
4. **Meet with the Veterans & Military Advisor** – All new students must meet with the Veterans & Military Advisor before scheduling classes. Use this link to schedule your appointment: <https://hagerstown.craniumcafe.com/rsmith6hagerstownccedu>.
5. **Apply for your Educational Benefits** at: va.gov/education/how-to-apply.

Chapter 30 Montgomery GI Bill Active Duty (MGIB-AD)

- For 36 non-consecutive months of educational benefit; all VA payments (usually a BAH payment only) go directly to the student.
- Students must set up an HCC payment plan or use federal financial aid to pay tuition and fees by the established HCC payment due deadline.

Chapter 31 Veterans Readiness & Employment (VR&E).

- Students must meet with and get approval from the VR&E Counselor.
- VA payment for tuition will go directly to HCC.
- BAH is paid directly to the student.

Chapter 33 Post 9/11 GI Bill

- For 36 non-consecutive months of educational benefits.
- VA payment for tuition will go directly to HCC.
- Book allotment and BAH paid directly to the student via pre-determined direct deposit.

Chapter 35 Dependent Education Assistance (DEA)

- Eligibility limited to dependents of veterans who are 100% disabled, MIA, KIA, or POW.
- For 36 non-consecutive months, all VA payments (usually a BAH payment only) go directly to the student.
- Students must set up an HCC payment plan or use federal financial aid to pay tuition and fees by the established HCC payment due deadline.

Chapter 1606 Montgomery GI Bill Selective Reserve (MGIB-SR)

- For 36 non-consecutive months of educational benefit, all VA payments (usually a BAH payment only) go directly to the student.
- Students must set up an HCC payment plan or use federal financial aid to pay tuition and fees by the established HCC payment due deadline.
- Tuition Assistance available for Reservists on Active-Duty Status (Title 10 Orders).
- Students must load a program evaluation, completed by an Academic Advisor, into the military educational portal.

Veteran students whose VA benefits do not cover 100% of tuition and fee costs are responsible for paying the remaining balance owed before the end of the semester of enrollment.
