Through the Early College Degree Program, students are given the opportunity to earn 30 college credits or more, and many are able to complete requirements for certificates and associate degrees by the time they graduate from high school.

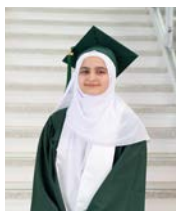
Alumni Speaker

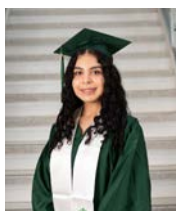

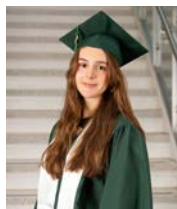
