Admission to HCC does not guarantee admission to the Division of Nursing.

- Apply for admission to HCC (www.hagerstowncc.edu/admissions)
- Submit official transcripts from all colleges attended (students who took classes at HCC do not need to submit official HCC transcripts) by the application deadline.
 - o Foreign-educated students must have their college transcripts evaluated by World Education Services (WES)
 - o If using AP scores to meet any of the General Education requirements, submit official AP scores.
- Submit official high school or GED transcripts by the application deadline.
- Start your General Education/Prerequisite classes.

The requirements below must be completed and submitted to the Admissions Office. The deadline to apply to the Practical Nursing program is March 15th.

1. Submit a completed program application known as the Supplemental Application for Practical Nursing.
 2. Submit official TEAS scores (students who took TEAS at HCC do not need to submit an official copy). The TEAS Test must be completed within 3 years of application deadline with minimum scores of 60 overall & 69 reading (www.hagerstowncc.edu/teas).
 3. Watch the Nursing Preview Program (www.hagerstowncc.edu/academics/divisions/nursing/nursing-preview-program).
- BIO 203 must be completed and BIO 204 must be completed or in progress by the application deadline.
 - ENG 101 must be completed or in progress at the application deadline.
 - PSY 101 must be completed or in progress at the application deadline.
 - MAT 090 or MAT 095 must be completed or in progress (Math Gen Ed not required).
 - Completion of all required science courses must be within seven years prior to admission to the program.
 - A minimum cumulative grade point average for all college coursework of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. In addition, a minimum grade point average of 2.5 for all program required general education courses is required. While this is the minimum requirement, it is advised that students have the highest-grade point average possible for the best chance of being selected into the program.
 - A grade of “C” or higher is required for all general education requirements. “D’s” and “F’s” must be retaken and be completed before applying for the program. While this is the minimum requirement, it is recommended that students obtain the highest grade possible in each class.

The Nursing program is a Maryland Health Manpower Shortage program. All students who apply for this program must be eligible to work in the State of Maryland at the application deadline and throughout the program.
