Admission Requirements: Admission to HCC does not guarantee admission to the Division of Nursing.

- Apply for admission to HCC (www.hagerstowncc.edu/admissions)
- Submit official transcripts from all colleges attended (students who took classes at HCC do not need to submit official HCC transcripts) by the application deadline.
 - If using AP scores to meet any of the General Education requirements, submit official AP scores.
 - Foreign-educated students must have their college transcripts evaluated by World Education Services (WES)
- Submit official high school or GED transcripts. Submit SAT scores (If taken within 5 years of the application date)
- Start your General Education/Prerequisite classes.

The requirements below must be completed and submitted to the Admissions Office by the application deadline to be considered for the Daytime Nursing Program (January 15 for the Fall nursing class and July 15 for the Spring nursing class).

1. Watch the Nursing Preview Program (www.hagerstowncc.edu/academics/divisions/nursing/nursing-preview-program).
 2. Submit the Supplemental Application for Nursing Program (RN) by the program application deadline.
 3. Complete at least 12 credits of program-required general education classes with a grade of 'C' or higher and have BIO 203 (Anatomy and Physiology I) completed or in progress by the program application deadline.
 4. Complete the TEAS test by program application deadline with minimum scores of 60% Overall & 69% in Reading. Official scores must be submitted to the Admissions Office (students who took the TEAS test at HCC do not need to submit an official copy). TEAS scores are valid for 3 years. An explanation of the TEAS test can be found at www.hagerstowncc.edu/teas. Scoring higher on the TEAS test, will give you more points towards being accepted into the program.
- Completion of all required science courses must be within seven years prior to the application deadline.
 - A minimum cumulative grade point average for all college coursework of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale is required. In addition, a minimum grade point average of 2.5 for all program required general education courses is required. While this is the minimum requirement, it is advised that students have the highest-grade point average possible for the best chance of being selected into the program.
 - A grade of "C" or higher is required for all program required general education courses. "D's" and "F's" must be retaken and completed before applying for the program. While this is the minimum requirement, it is recommended that students obtain the highest grade possible in each class.

The Nursing program is a Maryland Health Manpower Shortage program. All students who apply for this program must be eligible to work in the State of Maryland at the application deadline and throughout the program.
