



Getting Started at HCC



To be ready to schedule your classes, please make sure to complete the following steps.

1. Submit an online Application for Admission at www.hagerstowncc.edu/admissions.
2. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student (FAFSA) - if applicable.
 - If you plan to use financial aid or apply for scholarships to finance your college education, you must complete the FAFSA. Submit the form online at <https://studentaid.gov>. For more information about financial aid or scholarships, go to www.hagerstowncc.edu/financial-aid or call 240-500-2473.
3. Submit official transcripts to the Office of Admissions.
 - This may include high school transcripts, college/university transcripts, and GED scores.
 - High school students taking classes on campus must also complete the Early College Access Form found at www.hagerstowncc.edu/earlycollegeaccess.
4. Review placement testing information online at: www.hagerstowncc.edu/testing.
 - You may be exempt from taking the placement tests based on high school GPA, SAT, ACT, MCAP, AP, IB, GED, or CLEP scores. To see if you are exempt from testing, visit www.hagerstowncc.edu/testing. If you are exempt from placement testing based on one of these, please submit an official copy of the transcript or test scores to the Office of Admissions

5. All new students must meet with a Student Support Advisor to register for classes. To schedule an appointment or see walk in hours, visit www.hagerstowncc.edu/advising.
 - Students taking classes at their high school do not need to schedule an appointment to register. HCC will work with each high school to register these classes.
