### TRANSFERRING MADE EASY

#### **Electronic Tool for Transfer Students**

**ARTSYS** is a computerized data information system which informs students and advisors at a community college about the transferability of each community college course.

In addition to providing information on course transferability, the program provides, in community college course numbers, the recommended courses for transfer to specific programs of study at participating four-year institutions.

With the ARTSYS program, students enter their transcripts into the system to determine the transferability of their courses to one or more institutions. For information, contact the transfer advisor on your community college campus.

#### **Transfer Glossary**

<u>Credit Hour</u>: One semester hour of credit is awarded for a minimum of 15 hours (50 minutes each) of actual class time; for 30 hours of laboratory time; or for 45 hours of instructional situations such as practice, internships, and cooperative education placements. (For example, a 3-credit lecture course meets for 45 hours – usually two or three times per week for 15 weeks.)

<u>Native Student</u>: A student whose initial college enrollment was at a given institution of higher education and who has not ever transferred to another institution.

<u>Receiving Institution</u>: The institution of higher education to which a transfer student currently desires to enroll or has enrolled.

<u>Recommended Transfer Program</u>: A planned program of courses, including both general education and courses in the major, taken at a community college which is applicable to a Bachelor's degree program at a receiving institution. Ordinarily, transfer credits are limited to half the Bachelor's degree program requirements.

<u>Sending Institution</u>: The previous institution of higher education at which a transfer student earned transferable, academic credit.

<u>Transfer Student</u>: A student entering an institution for the first time with transferable, academic credit earned at another college.
