Also provides assistance to making positive choices, regarding unplanned pregnancy including counseling with parents, boyfriend or husband; referrals to agencies that provide financial assistance, housing, legal aid and adoption services; furnishes maternity and infant clothing and car seats when available; distributes diapers and formula, when available; and budget counseling. Abstinence until marriage educational program is offered for teens, young adults and singles.
