Discussion of Analysis Results: (narrative in Word format of who, what, where, when, what was discussed and what was determined)

We (Lori Spessard & Stacey McGee) were able to see a few patterns in the data for this year:

- Unlike previous semesters, no significant patterns emerged.
- The variation in results by section was much greater than in previous years, with some sections
 doing extremely well and other doing very poorly. (Highest result by section was 100% and the
 lowest was 46%.)
- The shortest-length section did very well, which is different from previous semesters.

Some possible reasons:

We do not have an explanation for this year's results since no pattern emerged. No changes
had been made to the project's requirements from the previous year. Additional reminders and
resources related to the project were added to the Moodle site (per our Plan of Action from last
year). It is unclear if this had any impact.
