- -Part 2: Categories of Knowledge 35 credits
 - ACategory A Logic & Numbers for Rational Thinking (1 course 3 credits)
 - BCategory B Linguistic, Literary, Artistic, & Cultural Traditions (3 courses 9 credits)
 - Category C Biological & Physical Sciences (3 courses 9 credits)
 - DCategory D Political, Economic, and Geographic Sciences (2 courses 6 credits)
 - ECategory E Social and Behavioral Sciences (2 courses 6 credits)

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NOTES (IMPORTANT, PLEASE READ)

- 1. Additional transfer credits may be taken at HCC for transfer to Shippensburg. Please speak with your advisor and/or the SU transfer advisor for advisement on additional coursework.
- 2. 0-Level courses **do not** count toward graduation requirements and **will not transfer**.
- 3. Courses for Shippensburg University have been selected by joint agreement of HCC and SU. However, curricula are subject to change.
