NOTES (IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ):

- 1. Additional transfer credits may be taken at HCC for transfer to Shippensburg. Please speak with your advisor and/or the SU transfer counselor for advisement on additional coursework.
- 2. 0-Level courses do not count toward graduation requirements and will not transfer. HD courses may not transfer.
- 3. Courses for Shippensburg University have been selected by joint agreement of HCC and SU. However, curricula are subject to change. Please speak with your advisor and/or the SU transfer counselor if you have any questions. A transfer counselor from SU visits the campus on a regular basis through the academic year. Call the SU Office of Admissions or HCC Academic Advisement for specific days and times.
- 4. B.A. students must satisfy the Novice level competency in a foreign language. This is accomplished via 3 years of the same language in high school, an AP score of at least 2, or the completion of a 103 level course. Three credits of a foreign language may count under category B general education requirement. In order to transfer into the Political Science program at Shippensburg, students must have at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA.
