- ^CCategory C Biological & Physical Sciences (3 courses 9 credits)
- ^DCategory D Political, Economic, and Geographic Sciences (2 courses 7 credits)
- ^ECategory E Social and Behavioral Sciences (2 courses 6 credits

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SPECIAL NOTES (IMPORTANT, PLEASE READ)

- 1. Additional transfer credits may be taken at HCC for transfer to Shippensburg. Please speak with your advisor and/or the SU transfer counselor for advisement on additional coursework.
- 2. 0-Level courses do not count toward graduation requirements and will not transfer. FS courses may not transfer.
- 3. Courses for Shippensburg University have been selected by joint agreement of HCC and SU. However, curricula are subject to change. Please speak with your advisor and/or the SU transfer counselor if you have any questions. A transfer counselor form SU visits HCC on a monthly basis throughout the academic year.
- 4. B.A. students must satisfy the Novice level competency in a foreign language. This is accomplished via 3 years of the same language in high school, an AP score of at least 2, or the completion of a 103 level course. Three credits of a foreign language may count under category B general education requirement.
- 5. In order to transfer into the Psychology program at Shippensburg, students must have at least a 2.3 cumulative GPA.
