Hagerstown Community College conducts a Survey of Previously Enrolled Students every other year (odd years). The purpose of the survey is to find out why students attend one semester, but do not return the following semester (Spring to Fall). Results from Question 3 are reported on HCC's annual Accountability Report (Indicator 2).

1,223 surveys were mailed on December 3, 2015 to students that attended Spring 2015 but did not return for the Fall 2015 term. Each student received a cover letter, survey, and reply envelope. As an incentive, students who provided their name, email, and/or phone number were entered into a drawing to win a \$50 Amazon gift card. A total of **144** completed surveys were returned, a response rate of **11.8%**.
